

Absentee Voting Hours:

Early voting hours in Minnesota's 2026 General Election run from Friday, September 18th – Monday, November 2nd

During the absentee voting period (Friday, September 18th – Thursday, October 15th) Steele County voters can vote by mail or in person at the Property Tax & Elections Office in the Steele County Administration Center, 630 Florence Ave., Owatonna, MN 55060 during the following times:

- 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday

Anyone voting early must fill out an application in order to receive an absentee ballot.

During the early voting period (Friday, October 16th – Monday, November 2nd) Steele County voters can vote in person in Room 40 (downstairs) in the Steele County Administration Center, 630 Florence Ave., Owatonna, MN 55060 during the following times:

- 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday until October 30th
- 9:00 a.m. – 3 p.m. Saturday, October 24th
- 8:00 a.m. – 7 p.m. Tuesday, October 27th
- 9:00 a.m. – 3 p.m. Saturday, October 31st
- 9:00 a.m. – 3 p.m. Sunday, November 1st
- 8:00 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday, November 2nd

Anyone voting early must fill out an application in order to receive an absentee ballot
