ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PERMIT GUIDELINES

Steele County Annual Transportation Permits are only valid for the year in which they are issued. Steele County will issue Annual Transportation Permits, on an individual vehicle basis, under the following circumstances:

OVERWEIGHT

- Overweight Annual Transportation Permits will only be issued during the Legal Load Limit time period under the following conditions:
 1. The Applicant's only direct access to a field or business is onto a roadway posted at less than 9-ton/axle during Legal Load Limits
 2. The Applicant must use a defined shortest route to a roadway posted at 9-ton/axle or higher during Legal Load Limits
 3. The County Engineer will make the final determination on the shortest route to be used
- Overweight Annual Transportation Permits will NOT be valid during Spring Load Restrictions (No Exceptions)

OVERSIZE

- Oversize Annual Transportation Permits will only be issued if one of the following two situations apply:
 1. Designated Route
 - The Applicant must designate the route to be used
 - Unlimited Oversize trips will be allowed by the permitted vehicle on the designated route
 2. Various Routes
 - The Applicant must be a business located in Steele County whose primary Oversize trips originate or terminate in Steele County
 - The County Engineer will make the final determination on the eligibility of a business to qualify for this type of permit
