

Absentee Voting Hours:

Early voting hours in Minnesota's 2026 Primary Election run from Friday, June 26th – Monday, August 10th

During the absentee voting period (Friday, June 26th – Thursday, July 23rd) Steele County voters can vote by mail or in person at the Property Tax & Elections Office in the Steele County Administration Center, 630 Florence Ave., Owatonna, MN 55060 during the following times:

- 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday until July 23rd (except on July 3rd as we are closed for the holiday)

Anyone voting early must fill out an application in order to receive an absentee ballot.

During the early voting period (Friday, July 24th – Monday, August 10th) Steele County voters can vote in person in Room 40 (downstairs) in the Steele County Administration Center, 630 Florence Ave., Owatonna, MN 55060 during the following times:

- 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday until August 9th
- 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday, August 10th
- 9:00 a.m. – 3 p.m. Saturday, August 8th

Anyone voting early must fill out an application in order to receive an absentee ballot
