

Agency	Naloxone Access
Sterling Pharmacy	Free emergency naloxone kits and training, as well as OTC Narcan and prescription fulfillment. Fentanyl test strips available.
Walgreens Pharmacy	Over-the-counter nasal Narcan spray available in stores across the state and online.
Cash Wise Pharmacy	Over-the-counter nasal Narcan spray available.
CVS Pharmacy (Owatonna Target)	Over-the-counter nasal Narcan spray available in stores across the state and online.
Walmart Pharmacy	Over-the-counter nasal Narcan spray available in stores across the state and online.
HyVee Pharmacy	Over-the-counter nasal Narcan spray available in stores across the state.
Genoa Pharmacy	OTC Narcan, covers other forms of naloxone with a prescription.
Law enforcement	All county law enforcement and EMTs carry Naloxone.
Schools	All school buildings are equipped with at least 2 doses of Naloxone.

HealthFinders	Currently no permanent MAT providers in Steele County location, however these providers can travel to Steele upon request or will take patients from Steele in Rice County locations.

Agency	Treatment and Recovery Options
South Central Human Relations Center (SCHRC)	Dual recovery program in which clients meet with licensed drug and alcohol counselors and can undergo medication-assisted treatment with providers prescribing Suboxone. - Funding is accepted from most major insurance providers, the Behavioral Health Fund, or an individual fee for service. - DRP is offered to both adolescents and adults.
Safe Harbour (through SCHRC)	12-bed Intensive Residential Treatment (IRT) program for adults in need of behavioral health and support services. The focus is to help people with a mental or chemical illness avoid hospitalizations or promote continued stabilization following a hospitalization. Staff utilizes evidence-based practices to help residents create their treatment plan and chart a path for recovery.
Beyond Brink & WRecovery Owatonna	Safe and supportive, 'sober' housing for those who are self-motivated to improve their lives through the process of recovery and whole health wellness. Offer support, structure and resources that encourage long term wellness to those who are transitioning back into the community, seeking stabilization. Initial Admission Requirements: - Must be 18 years of age - Must be working a program of recovery - Must be a self-admit person with substance use disorder seeking recovery Also offer a virtual youth support group, virtual peer recovery support, and telephone recovery support.

Agency	Treatment and Recovery Options
MNPrairie (Steele County)	Substance Use (SU) services are available to MNPrairie county residents who have concerns about their substance use and meet the eligibility guidelines, or have been referred by the court for services. Services Include: Comprehensive Assessments, Detoxification/Withdrawal Management, Treatment Coordination, and Referral for Rule 31 substance use treatment programs for residential and non-residential treatment services, supportive housing, treatment coordination, and drug courts.
Allina Health	Opioid treatment program, chronic pain rehabilitation program, and alternative pain management options.
Mayo Clinic	Alternative pain management options, education, provides information on recovery support groups and outpatient services.
HealthFinders Collaborative (Owatonna)	Currently no permanent MAT providers or LADCs in Steele County location, however these providers can travel to Steele upon request or will take patients from Steele in Rice County locations • Can do chemical health assessments and management and prescription of suboxone regardless of an individual's county of residence or insurance status • Bilingual providers • Faribault location offers Syringe Services Program where individuals can access sterile syringes, Naloxone, and fentanyl test strips
South Country Health Alliance	Opioid case management; patient prevention model. Connect with those that are newly prescribed opioids, have had 2 or more prescriptions, or are opioid naïve, to provide alternative options and resources that are covered by insurance.
Fountain Centers (Owatonna, Albert Lea); affiliated with Mayo Clinic	Provide Intensive Outpatient Treatment, Outpatient Treatment (relapse track), individual counseling, group counseling, and cognitive skills. They provide comprehensive assessments and have a virtual / hybrid component to treatment with an in-person option. There are both AM and PM groups. Intensive Outpatient programming is open to all genders, adult and adolescent.

Agency	Treatment and Recovery Options
Catholic Charities of Southern MN (Owatonna)	Family, marriage, relationship, child and individual counseling services are available to people of all ages, ethnic/cultural backgrounds, faith and non-faith traditions and economic backgrounds. Telehealth available.
Beauterre Recovery Institute (Owatonna)	Serves individuals who have been assessed with substance abuse disorder with or without co-occurring mental health issues requiring residential treatment for support, structure, and monitoring. A special track is offered for professionals addressing work-specific issues and coping skills to meet licensing requirements. Relapse prevention education is also available. Immediate placement for both men and women; Private or commercial Insurance only.
Schools	Social workers and counselors on staff can offer guidance and resources to students and parents.
Narcotics Anonymous (Owatonna)	12-step program with regularly scheduled meetings for people who want to quit using substances.
